Munich Conference	A conference in Germany where the Churchill, Daladier, Mussolini, and Hitler discussed the appeasement of Sudetenland
Appeasement	The practice of giving in to one nation's aggression in order to avoid war
Nazi-Soviet Pact	An agreement between Stalin and Hitler where they agreed not to attack each other.
Blitzkrieg	Lightning War
Battle of Britain	A battle in London where German planes dropped a plethora of bombs
Lend-Lease Act	A law where sales or loans of war materials to any country whose defense the President deems important to the US
Atlantic Charter	Set goals for the postwar world such as: --Seek no territory from the war --Support the right of people to choose a form of government under which they will live. --Called for a replacement to the league of nations
